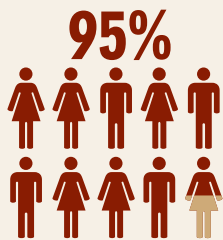

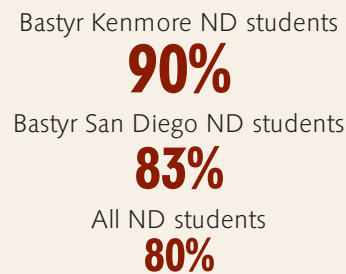

STUDENT RETENTION RATES

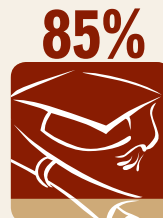


EXAM PASSAGE RATES*

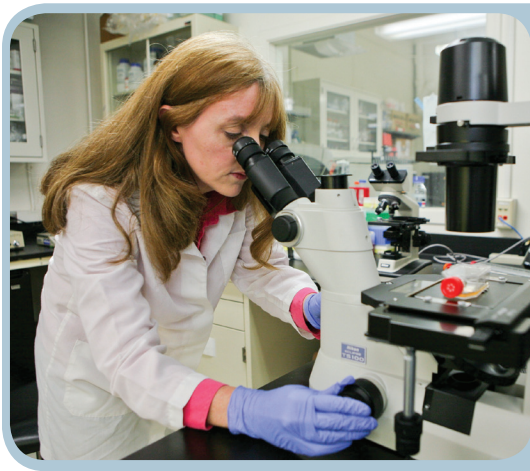
Clinical Training

Because Bastyr University places effective clinical training at the core of health education, all graduate and first-professional students train at the University's teaching clinics in Seattle and San Diego, where clinical faculty members emphasize an integrative approach to healing.

At the forefront of scientific verification of natural treatments and practices, Bastyr University was the first natural medicine institution to establish a research laboratory, was the first naturopathic school to receive funding from the National Institutes of Health (NIH) and has hosted a number of multimillion-dollar NIH studies.
