PREREQUISITES

The CCHM is a postgraduate course of study that includes both didactic and clinical training. Applications for the certificate program are taken from licensed acupuncturists throughout the year, with admission starting in summer quarter. An interview may be required.

MASTER OF SCIENCE IN ACUPUNCTURE PREREQUISITES

Entering students must have a bachelor's degree or meet the general education proficiencies and must have completed the following courses or their equivalent:

- Intermediate Algebra.....1 course
- General Chemistry (allied-health level with lab).....1 course
- General Biology (allied-health level with lab).....1 course
- General Physics (allied-health level with lab).....1 course
- General Psychology.....1 course

Note: All students must complete a CPR-C level course or equivalent prior to entering clinic.
