

## ACCREDITATION

All degree offerings at Bastyr University are accredited by the Northwest Commission on Colleges and Universities ([www.nwccu.org](http://www.nwccu.org)). The Doctor of Naturopathic Medicine program is accredited by the Council on Naturopathic Medical Education (CNME), a specialized accrediting board recognized by the U.S. Department of Education. Bastyr University is approved by the U.S. Immigration and Naturalization Service to accept and enroll foreign nonimmigrant students. The California Board of Behavioral Sciences has officially approved the curriculum of the Masters in Counseling Psychology program for LPCC licensure eligibility (Licensed Professional Clinical Counselor).

## SAN DIEGO CAMPUS

San Diego is California's second-largest city, offering world-class attractions, arts, culture and endless outdoor recreation opportunities.

Bastyr University California is just a few miles from expansive coastal wilderness and stunning beaches, including Del Mar, Torrey Pines and La Jolla. It borders Los Penasquitos Canyon Reserve, with more than 4,000 acres of hiking biking and equestrian trails.

It is approximately 14 miles north of downtown and is situated on more than 41,000 square feet with ample space for learning and connecting.


